Alabama – West Florida Conference Debbie Bracewell, President

Events that took place at Annual Conference have certainly given us as United Women in Faith several issues to discuss. Realigning of districts is not an easy task, and I have been inundated with questions and comments that cannot be answered quickly. I would like to suggest that we take the time from July 2023 to 2024 to investigate how to best realign our districts/district business as the church conference has realigned theirs.

Rationale:

- 1. If I am reading the signs correctly, it appears that the districts in the Panhandle of Florida will, at some point, be part of the Florida Conference. If those two districts are already paired, that process may be easier for them and for us.
- 2. Through a long process, budgets have been prepared for 2023-2024. Postponing realignment will give us the opportunity to continue business as usual with the knowledge that next year, budgets can be compiled by those in the districts that will be newly aligned for 2025.
- 3. I may be wrong, but I don't believe the districts know exactly which churches still have units and which churches do not. Communication must be made with the local churches to see if a UMC church still has a unit and/or if a disaffiliated church unit wishes to remain in UWFaith.
- 4. Elections will be taking place this fall for conference and district officers. Postponing realignment will give us the opportunity to continue business as usual with the knowledge that next year, officers can be recruited and elected from members in the districts that will be newly aligned in 2025.
