A tremendous “thank you” to each of you for your dedication and unity and best efforts this year to fulfill the last phrase of our United Methodist Women Purpose: to expand concepts of mission through participation in the global ministries of the church.

Members from several of our units attended the very informative mission study: Women United for Change – 150 Years in Mission hosted by the Montgomery-Opelika District in June. And we are grateful to all those who worked so hard to provide us the opportunity this year to virtually participate in three outstanding studies at **Mission U in July**.

I would encourage each of you to visit two websites containing helpful information about items discussed in this article. Our national website is unitedmethodistwomen.org, and the home page displays several helpful icons such as **Faith Talks**, **Response** magazine, and the Legacy Fund. The page also contains a Site Map with a lengthy list of topics. Our Conference website is awf-umw.org and is also easy to navigate.

The Reading Program 2021-2022 is in full swing. On the national website, download the book lists (including the 34 additional titles to this year’s list) and the reporting form. Also available is the latest info from Andris Salter, Operations Officer. **Faith Talks**, which are conversations on mission, advocacy, and spiritual-growth topics, are hosted online and can be joined live or listened to online anytime. The link is on the national website. **Two** Faith Talks count as **one book** read, and **three** count as **two books**. Three movies on the list count as a book each: **Just Mercy, The Hate U Give, and Pushout**. The reporting form can be downloaded on the website, and you may also subscribe to **Response** magazine.

Remember that mission giving is our method of contributing funds to support vital ministries and advocacy nationally and around the world, to support regional missionaries, and to fund our educational resources. Visit “Where the Money Goes” on our national website. Learn or “brush up” about our Five Channels of Mission Giving, along with World Thank Offering and Call to Prayer & Self-Denial programs and opportunities of giving.

Encourage your members to participate in our Mission Today program and thereby complete the criteria for a Mission Today Unit. You may download the criteria/reporting form on the Conference website, awf-umw.org. Our units are performing many of these items already in our meetings, programs, and ministry. It’s fun to achieve a goal and have your unit recognized with an award. THANK YOU for your love of others, your hard work and your sacrifices of time and money to enable United Methodist Women to fulfill our mission. May we continue to be informed and transformed to better serve God’s purpose for us at this time in His beautifully created world.
